



To Whom It May Concern:

The Chicago Sculpture Exhibit's mission is to bring large-scale sculpture to the communities of Chicago in an effort to broaden the perspectives of public art, and make it accessible to people as they go about their daily lives. It is the only such program in the city.

We reach out to you today to invite you to become a sponsor as a way to support your local communities, and enhance and enliven the neighborhood where your family and friends work and live.

CSE places about 50 sculptures throughout Chicago's neighborhoods annually. Each fall, CSE sends a call to sculptors nationwide to participate in our annual Exhibition. Our sponsors, board members and community representatives gather in January to jury the submissions, and then the process to match sponsors with the selected sculptures begins. The previous year's sculptures are rotated out, with a new exhibit installed in May.

A sponsorship is \$4,000.00 per year, per sculpture. As a sponsor, your name is recognized at the sculpture site, and your name and logo are listed in all publications and on our social media. Should you choose to participate, please send us your logo so that we can acknowledge your contribution.

If you'd prefer to contribute in another way, please consider donating to the CSE Richard J. Hunt Award, established in 2021 to celebrate our 20th Anniversary. This \$10,000 award is intended to reach a more diverse audience of emerging artists, and increase opportunities for those sculptors who, without this grant, may not have sufficient funding to create large-scale outdoor sculpture. Salvador Jimenez-Flores is the 2023 Richard Hunt Award winner, and his sculpture, *Caminantes*, will be installed in June as part of our show.
